Workshop II: ROLE OF BUSINESS IN URBAN DEVELOPMENT*(moderator Mr. Mikhail Gaukhfeld)*

Housing in metropolitan areas presents city companies, policymakers and housing companies with challenging questions about new construction, development of the quarter and consolidation. Often, housing demand exceeds supply, above all because of a growing population.
